- Yr 3 & Yr 5 Reading - 100% achieving National Minimum Standard.
- Yr 3 Reading - 80% achieving upper two bands.
- Yr 5 Reading - 65% achieving upper two bands
- Yr 3 & Yr 5 Writing - 100% achieving National Minimum Standard
- Yr 3 Writing - 67% achieving upper two bands
- Yr 5 Writing - 35% achieving upper two bands

An expert teaching team and strong intervention strategies:

- Continue to build teacher pedagogy through researched best practice of Curiosity and Powerful Learning, including but not limited to professional development, Yr level planning sessions, triad observation cycles- 2 per term and networking with like schools group.
- Continued targeted intervention for all students including the emphasis on low achieving, increasing EALD co-hort and high achieving students.
- Increased support for the 'at risk' students through increasing Support Services, such as Guidance, Speech and Senior STL&N
